

9. ERADICATING ONE TYPE OF INJUSTICE

In the same vein as the Gates Foundation systematically works on diseases such as malaria or tuberculosis, a major effort can be launched to tackle family justice or employment justice. User-centred design would lead to accessible and effective justice journeys, delivering solutions when and where families need them, see our report <u>Understanding Justice Needs</u> for the underlying vision and background data, The delivery models for these services would be further developed and implemented rigorously and monitored systematically. Starting in 5 countries, the results would become available for other countries soon.

9. FAMILY JUSTICE FOR ALL	
Goal:	Effective processes and treatments for separation, domestic violence, inheritance and other high risk events for children, women and men. Including prevention.
Activity	Research. Collecting best practices. Design. Creating networks and joint strategies, working with international family law organizations and organizations of professionals doing interventions with families. Developing products, platforms and services. Delivery models and implementation.
Deliverables	Smart relationship covenants that couples can use during their relationships. Awareness of risks and best practices in family relationships. Integrated justice journey from problem to solution: diagnosis, intake, negotiation, mediation, decision by a judge, aftercare. Evidence based guideline to support this. Online platforms. Services supporting the process. Innovative court procedure (problem solving) with assistance of bridge-builder built in. Systematic monitoring and review. A constant stream of research regarding effective treatments.
Proof of concept and partners	Experience from health care sector. Eradicating and treating diseases. UNICEF. UN Women. Children's rights foundations.
Business model	Philanthropy. Contributions in kind and in money from stakeholders (universities, governments, donors). License fees for innovations developed, to be paid by courts and legal services organizations. Social impact bonds.
First indication of resources needed	\$20 million per year for 10 years.
